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- The maximum number of points that can be earned in the assessment of Technical capacity is 100.
- Only tenderers with a score of at least 55 points of the overall <u>"Technical capacity"</u> evaluation qualify for the further comparison evaluation between the bidders.
- The highest-scoring tenderer for the <u>"Competences section"</u> is awarded a weighted technical score of 60.
- The others receive weighted technical score calculated using the following formula: Weighted technical score = (final score of the technical offer in question/final score of the best technical offer) x 60.
- The highest-scoring tenderer for the <u>"Specific professional experience</u>" is awarded a weighted technical score of 40.
- The others receive weighted technical score calculated using the following formula: Weighted technical score = (final score of the technical offer in question/final score of the best technical offer) x 60.

The most favorable bidder has the highest number of total points calculated according to the above criteria.
